BBUMC is excited to announce that we will resume in-person worship on Sunday, July 5, 2020 with worship at 8:30 and 11am.

We will do our best to "do no harm to the most vulnerable among us," but we want each person to make the choice that is best for them. With that being said, here are a few guidelines that we would like for everyone to follow.

- **Stay home** if you are not feeling well. **Worship online** will continue to be available (<u>www.bbumc.org</u>, you.
- **Masks** are strongly encouraged but not required. A limited number of masks will be available.
- Please use hand **sanitizer** when you enter the building.
- Please maintain **6 feet physical distancing** at all times, especially when entering and exiting the building.
- Families will be seated together, but all others will be 6 feet apart from other family groups or individuals. Families, please also keep your children with you before, during, and after worship.
- There will be **no nursery care** available at this time.
- There will be **no Sunday School** at this time. Children's Sunday School will continue through the summer with online lessons.
- There will be **no fellowship or Coffee and Conversations time** between worship services at this time.

As people of faith, we find great joy, meaning, and value in worshipping together. While online worship has been a useful tool, many are ready to resume in-person worship. If, because of health concerns, you are not ready to resume in-person worship, online worship will continue to be available. If this is the case, please also know that we'd love to find other ways to serve you, and help you continue to connect with the church and grow in your faith.
